

The No Doubt Shout Out

Isaiah 40.9-11 January 4, 2015

⁹You who bring good tidings to Zion, go up on a high mountain. You who bring good tidings to Jerusalem, lift up your voice with a shout, lift it up, do not be afraid; say to the towns of Judah, "Here is your God!" ¹⁰See, the Sovereign LORD comes with power, and his arm rules for him. See, his reward is with him, and his recompense accompanies him. ¹¹He tends his flock like a shepherd: He gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them close to his heart; he gently leads those that have young.



1. His Power To Reward

Heb 11.6: *And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.*

Heb 12.2: *Let us fix our eyes on Jesus...who for the joy set before him endured the cross...*

Now Gen 15.1: *"I am your shield, your very great reward."*

Psa. 73.26: *My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.*

Psa. 142.5: *I cry to you, O LORD; I say, "You are my refuge, my portion in the land of the living."*

Mt 13.11-12: *The knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you..., Whoever has will be given more, and he will have an abundance.*



Later Matt 16.27: *For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what he has done.*

1 Cor 13.12: *Now we see but a poor reflection as in a mirror; **then** we shall see face to face. **Now** I know in part; then I shall know **fully**, even as I am fully known.*
