I. The invitation to worship (v1-2)



Making a Joyful Noise

Come, let us sing for joy to the LORD; let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation. Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song.

II. The substance of worship (v3-5)

For the LORD is the great God, the great King above all gods. In his hand are the depths of the earth, and the mountain peaks belong to him. The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land.

III. Our response to worship (v6-7)

Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker; for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care.



IV. Our obedience to the One we worship (v7b-11)

Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as you did at Meribah, as you did that day at Massah in the desert, where your fathers tested and tried me, though they had seen what I did. For forty years I was angry with that generation; I said, “They are a people whose hearts go

astray, and they have not known my ways.” So I declared on oath in my anger; “They shall never enter my rest.”



Heb 3.7: “As the Holy Spirit says....:

But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin’s deceitfulness.
