John 15.8: *This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.*



My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one: I in them and you in me. I - The Obstacle to Glory

Phil 2.5-11: ... *In your relationships with one another, have the same attitude as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather he made himself nothing, by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death—even death on a cross! Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow - in heaven and on earth and under the earth - and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.*

II. The Path to Glory



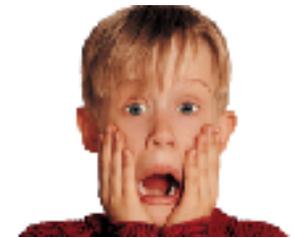
remove the speck from your brother's eye.

1. Application (of Biblical principles)

Mt 7.3-5: *Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother's eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye? ... **first** take the plank out of your own eye..., and **then** you will see clearly to*

2. Attitude (of Biblical thinking)

Phil 2.3: *Do **nothing** out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility **consider others better** than yourselves.*



3. Acts (of Biblical behavior)

John 13.12-17: *Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.*
