2 Timothy 3.10-17 September 24, 2017

You, however, know all about my teaching, my way of life, my purpose, faith, patience, love, endurance, persecutions, sufferings—what kinds of things happened to me in Antioch, Iconium and Lystra, the persecutions I endured. Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them. In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, while evil men and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom

you learned it, and how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.



Mt 5.17-18: *Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. I tell you the truth, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished.*

App 1:

I. "...teaching ..."

1. About God (Ps 113.5-6): *Who is like the LORD our God, the One who sits enthroned on high, who stoops down to look on the heavens and the earth?*



2. About ourselves (Is 42.5): *This is what God the LORD says—he who created the heavens and stretched them out, who spread out the earth and all that comes out of it, who gives breath to its people, and life to those who walk on it...*

3. About the universe (Heb 1.3): *"...the Son...sustains all things by his powerful word."*

II. "... rebuking ..."

About God (Is 55.9): *"As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."*

About ourselves (Mt 7.21): *"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.*

About our world (Eccl 1.9): *...nothing new under the sun.*
